
Nationally Defined Values for Authority Type

A	CONSENT ORDER An order issued by the Agency that is negotiated with a respondent. The terms of the order are discussed and agreed upon by both EPA and the respondent before the order is signed. A Consent Order has the same effect of a Unilateral Order, and therefore, any violation of a Consent Order will result in an enforcement action.
C	CONSENT DECREE
D	JUDICIAL DECREE An order by the court to undertake some activity or pay a fine to the government for violating RCRA and/or its regulation. It is not the result of an administrative action. A judge may either approve a settlement proposed by the parties, or he/she can impose his/her own remedy.
