NA	<b>Not applicable</b>	Do not use land-based units to manage hazardous secondary material.
OT	<b>Other</b>	Use other land-based unit(s) to manage hazardous secondary material.
PL	<b>Pile</b>	Use pile(s) to manage hazardous secondary material. Pile means any non-containerized accumulation of solid, non-flowing hazardous secondary material that is used for storage and is not a containment building.
SI	<b>Surface impoundment</b>	Use surface impoundment(s) to manage hazardous secondary material. A surface impoundment is a natural topographic depression, man-made excavation or diked are formed primarily of earthen materials (although it may be lined with man-made materials), which is designed to hold an accumulation of liquid hazardous secondary materials or materials containing free liquids and which is not an injection well.
